TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

NEW LEAGUE, NEW LOGO, WHO THIS?

The newly christened Pueblo Peppers make their unofficial debut in the North American Hockey League (NAHL) this weekend with a pair of exhibition contests against a South Division opponent, the New Mexico Ice Wolves. The Peppers will play a 59-game schedule - 28 home games, 28 road games, and three games at the NAHL Showcase in Blaine, MN at the end of September. The Peppers will open the regular season in late September at the NAHL Showcase before their home opener on October 2nd when they host the Idaho Falls Spud Kings. The Peppers schedule is compromised mostly of games within the Mountain Division - Billings, Grand Junction, Idaho Falls, and Ogden - but will also feature a home-and-home series with the Amarillo Wranglers of the South Division. Four of the five Mountain Division teams will play a crossover series with the South Division during the regular season.

ABOUT THE NORTH AMERICAN HOCKEY LEAGUE

Celebrating its 52nd season in 2026-27, the North American Hockey League (NAHL) is the oldest and one of the largest USA Hockey-sanctioned junior circuits with 36 teams representing some of the nation's emerging hockey markets, as well as, traditional hot beds in 21 states. It is one of the only two leagues in the United States that implements the tuition-free model.

The league hosts the NAHL Showcase in late September, the Top Prospects tournament in mid-February, and the Robertson Cup championship all from the Super Rink in Blaine, MN - just outside Minneapolis. Every preseason, regular season, and postseason is available live or on-demand on the official streaming platform for the league, NAHLTV. The platform gives fans access to all 36 NAHL teams **and** all 38 NA3HL teams all season long.

WAIT....I KNOW YOU FROM SOMEWHERE

The Peppers will feature some faces that hockey fans in Pueblo are familiar with - carrying four players from the Pueblo Bulls (NCDC) squad and one familiar divisional foe on the roster. Defenseman **Marcus Jackson** returns for his third season in Pueblo after setting career highs in all major categories while doubling his point output to 33 points (5-28-33) in his 54 games during his second season on the blueline. Jackson ('06/Lakeville, MN) was a force to be reckoned with in all three zones awhile averaging nearly 25:00 per game in ice time. Alongside Jackson, the forward trio **Jaeger Wood**, **Blake Schultz**, and **Landen Scherber** all join the Peppers for their first season in the NAHL. Schultz ('06/New London, MN) picked up 23 points (11-12-23) in his 54 games as a rookie, Wood ('07/Princeton, MN) led all Pueblo rookies with 11 goals in 52 games, and Scherber ('06/Monticello, MN) was a third-line staple in 52 of the team's 54 games in 2025-26.

Lastly, winger **Cooper Jacobson** dons the home colors for 2026-27 after terrorizing Pueblo last season as an opponent. Jacobson ('06/Chapel Hill, NC) picked up nine points in nine games against Pueblo as part of a 2025-26 campaign where he burst onto the scene as a rookie for the Ogden Mustangs by pocketing 43 points (14-29-43) in 54 games for a divisional rival. The forward scored frequently in volume and in games last season, which was a very, very good thing for his team. With at least a point last season in 27 games, Jacobson's team was a ridiculous 25-1-0-1.

SCOUTING THE ICE WOLVES

The New Mexico Ice Wolves bagged their fifth consecutive 30-win season in 2025/26, finishing with a 35-19-4-1 record and 75 points to finish 2nd in the South Division - tied for the highest finish in their seven year franchise history.

Last year's squad graduated fifteen different players to the NCAA Division I and Division III levels with college commitments - headlined by 30-goal scorer Andy Earl heading to Lindenwood University, team captain Sean Gibbons going to Army, and double digit goal scorers Stanley Hubbard and Nayan Pai committing to Robert Morris University and St. Olaf College respectively. With the wave of departures, the team will need to do heavy lifting on the power play - graduating over 80% of their goal scoring and nearly 90% of the power play offense from 2025-26. The Ice Wolves have navigated rebuilding waters successfully before - their 2024/25 squad had to replace over 80% of their scoring from the year prior and still won 33 games and finished fourth in the South - and second year head coach Kyle McKenzie will look to guide New Mexico to another strong season in the South Division.

Wilhite enters his first season as the head coach of the Peppers after spending the previous seven seasons as the coach of the Pueblo Bulls. In Wilhite's seven seasons in charge of the Bulls, the team made five playoff appearances and helped over 50 players earn college scholarships to the NCAA Division I and Division III levels with some alumni now in their professional careers across the Europe and the United States. As a player, Wilhite spent four seasons ('10-14) with the El Paso Rhinos and is tied for fifth all-time in franchise history in games (144) and second all-time among defenseman in points (121). Wilhite won a Thorne Cup championship in the 2013-14 season before accepting a college commitment to St. Mary's University (MN).



DAVE NELSON

**ASSOCIATE
HEAD COACH**

Nelson enters his first season as the associate head coach of the Peppers after spending the previous seven seasons as the coach of the Pueblo Bulls. He played three seasons of junior hockey with the El Paso Rhinos ('11-14) and finished his career sixth all-time in franchise scoring (139 points) and won a Thorne Cup championship during the 2013-14 season. Nelson graduated from St. Mary's University with a B.A. in Business Management.



VINNIE BOHN

Bohn will serve as the Peppers' first general manager in team history and brings a playing and coaching background that stretches back over a decade and a half. Bohn began his coaching career with the Topeka Roadrunners (NAHL) in 2015 and has since served as an assistant coach for the El Paso Rhinos (WSHL/NA3HL), Cedar Rapids Roughriders (USHL), and an assistant coach/general manager for the New Mexico Ice Wolves (NAHL). Passionate about mentorship and athlete advancement, Bohn has also served as a coach and mentor with the Nashville Jr. Predators 18UAAA program and as part of TPH Academy Nashville. During his playing career, Bohn spent four seasons with Green Mountain, Granite City, and the El Paso Rhinos before earning a commitment to play collegiate hockey at Worcester State University (NCAA DIII). Bohn played for four seasons, wearing an "A" in his final collegiate season.



MARTY WAKELYN

Wakelyn enters his first season with the Peppers after spending the previous three seasons as the Director of Scouting, play-by-play announcer and goalie coach for the Pueblo Bulls. In his time as the goaltending coach, Wakelyn worked with multiple goaltenders to help them earn NCAA Division I, NCAA Division III scholarships, or help them transition to professional hockey in Europe. Originally from British Columbia, Wakelyn was a four-year starting goaltender for Colorado College (NCAA) and is 7th all-time in games played for the Tigers. After graduating, Wakelyn signed with the New York Islanders and spent two seasons with the organization before retiring from hockey.
